ADVANTAGEOUS LOCATION

The Kyrgyz Republic borders Kazakhstan to the north, Uzbekistan to the west and north-west, Taiikistan to the south-west, and China to the south and south-east.

The landscape includes all natural zones common for the northern hemisphere, except the tropics. By its administrative and territorial system the Kyrgyz Republic belongs to unitary states and consists of 7 oblasts (regions), (Chui, Issyk-Kul, Talas, Naryn, Jalalabat, Osh and Batken) and 2 cities of national status (Bishkek and Osh).







LIBERAL LEGISLATION

- National treatment of business activities, equal investment rights of domestic and foreign investors, no intervention into the business activities of investors, protection and restitution of infringed rights of investors in accordance with the legislation of the Kyrqyz Republic;

- Export or repatriation of profit gained on investment,

- Protection against expropriation

- The investor's right to freely use the income derived from their activities in the Kyrgyz Republic;

- The freedom to invest in any form into objects and activities not prohibited by the legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic, including the activities subject to licensing;

- Freedom of monetary transactions
- Free access to open-source information

SKILLED AND EDUCATED WORKFORCE

There are 51 universities and 244 technical, vocational education and training institutions in the Kyrgyz Republic. Over the past year, there were more than 48.000 graduates.

The unemployment rate is 6.9%, and literacy rate is 995%

STABILIZATION MODE

In the event of amendments to the Law of the KR on Investments, or the tax legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic or the nontax payments legislation, the investor and the investee who meet the statutory requirements have the right, during 10 years from the date of signing the stabilization agreement, to choose such conditions as

may be most favourable to them for paying taxes including value added tax but excluding other indirect taxes, and nontax payments (except fees and charges for public services) in the manner provided by the laws of the Kyrgyz Republic. The procedure and conditions for applying stabilization regime to tax and nontax legal relationships

are established by the laws of the Kyrgyz Republic





resort and recreational (mainly but concentrated around the lake Issyk-Kul and is characterized by the presence sanatorium-resort complex amenities and beaches);



active tourism (hiking, horseback riding, cycling, ecotourism, photography, rafting, caravanning, rural tourism, diving, hang gliding, etc.);



Cultural tourism along the Silk Road - acquaintance with the culture and traditions of people living on the Great Silk Road);



Winter tourism (ski, heliski);



Business tourism (MICE tourism) international summits, forums, symposia, conferences;



Event tourism (traditional onny, ethnogames, national holidays, creative festivals, competitions, exhibitions, sports events).

As per Government's Development Programs, Agriculture is considered to be key sector to focus on and under state support. Kyrgyz Republic has very advantageous position for development of agriculture industry for its favorable climate, naturally cultivated agro products, and territorial advantage. The territory of Kyrgyz Republic is divided into oblasts that have distinct geographic and climate conditions that offers comparative advantages. For example, in Chuy oblast the dominant agricultural product is sugar beet; Issyk-Kul oblast is famous with apples and pears; in Batken oblast farmers grow apricot (dried); Osh and Jalal-Abad oblasts are the largest producers of cotton and walnut, Naryn oblast is famous for cattle farming; and Talas oblast is the biggest exporter of kidney and soya beans.

Agriculture consists of the production and processing of agricultural products. This gives this industry more value-added and labor-intensive characteristics. The intensity of labor can be maintained at the expense of the rural population, since the majority of the country's population lives in rural areas.
